

Playground Layout and Painting

1. Choose the area you would like to paint your playground games.
2. Ensure that the dimension of the games that you have chosen will fit in your chosen space. Can be laid out in **any pattern that you choose**.
3. Painting surface must be clear of debris; rocks, dirt, etc.
4. When painting outside best results will be achieved on a dry day when the temperature is above 5° Celsius and there is very little or no wind.
5. Layout your stencil as you want it to appear. Some stencils will require assembly. Lay down the pieces and use masking tape to hold the stencils together. Stencils may be taped or weighted down to hold them securely in place while you are painting.
6. Follow all of the necessary safety precautions when using spray paint. Face masks, gloves, eye goggles and protective layers for shoes and clothes are recommended.
7. Spray the paint in the open sections of the stencil. Two thin layers of paint are better than one thick coat. Allow the paint to dry between coats and before lifting the stencil.
8. Remove any tape, and allow paint to dry on stencil(s) before placing back in the carton that it came in.
